

Sacrament Readiness Overview:

A New Approach to Sacrament Formation

We welcome you into the next phase of your child's spiritual journey of faith development as a family. Our Sacramental Preparation sessions are geared toward children who are actively involved in becoming a disciple of Christ while participating in our Faith Formation programs. We here at St. Mark are happy and honored to come alongside your family to help you prepare your child for the reception of Sacraments of Initiation.

In order to accompany your family on this next step, we will start by conducting a *Sacrament Readiness Intake Meeting* with both you and your child. Our goal is to determine where your child is on their faith journey and what faith session(s) will be a good fit to prepare them for the next part of the journey.

In this conversation, we are looking and listening for indicators that your child is developing into a disciple of Christ in order to enter into our Sacramental Preparation sessions. We are looking for children who know who is God, who is Jesus, attend Mass weekly, who are familiar with Bible stories and who have an active prayer life.

If your child is showing these indicators in their faith life, then we will invite you to join our Sacramental Preparation sessions. Throughout the course of the sessions parent involvement is expected. Parent involvement will look different depending on where the child is in their faith journey and how old they are.

























If this does not fit into your family life at this time, you are welcome to delay your child's sacramental preparation for another time.

We are always happy to revisit where your child is at on their faith journey, to place them in the faith formation session(s) that best meets their needs next. Their progress depends on many factors, the greatest of which is how the faith is being lived in your family life. This can be an overwhelming and daunting task and we are here to support you! We understand that spiritual growth is based on the individual and your child's journey may not happen at the same pace as another child. We are here to walk with you and your child all the way to the altar! We want your child to join us through initiation into the Catholic Church and celebrate Him with us!

The following logistical criteria must be met before an effective Sacrament Readiness Intake Meeting takes place.

Submitted Faith Formation Registration Form

Faith Formation Fee Payment: \$30 per student/\$100 family max (\$45 per student/\$15 family max for non-parishioners)			
At least 7 years of age and at least in 2 nd grade			
Turn in Copy of Baptismal Certificate			
1 st Communion Prep Fee: \$20 per participant			
Turn in Copy of 1 st Communion Certificate			
15 years old by April 1 st of Confirmation Year			
Confirmation Retreat Fee Payment: \$140 per participant (paid at registration)
